## IS THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR PAID ON SALES **COMMISSION?**

It is common for funeral directors to be paid, at least partially, on commission. **This becomes a prob**lem when the funeral director pushes more expensive products and services on you. Making end of life arrangements for a loved one is emotionally stressful enough. Spending more money doesn't make the situation easier. In fact, it can cause even more financial stress later. What matters is that your wishes are respected, and you feel confident you made the right choice.

### **OUR ANSWER:**

**Our funeral directors are not paid on commission.** They earn the same rate if they work with a family for a no-charge body donation as they do working with a family doing a full service casketed burial (typically the most expensive service). # IS THAT THE TOTAL PRICE?

Many funeral homes say they charge \$695, \$795, \$895 for cremation. **The problem is that it isn't an all-inclusive price.** And, they don't share the additional fees with you until they have picked up your loved one. Only at this point, will you learn about the removal fees, the cremation container fees, and the crematory fees. Your cost becomes much more than you were expecting.

#### **OUR ANSWER:**

**Our pricing is up front and honest.** No bait and switch. No hidden fees or gimmicks. If your family chooses to add additional services, we will tell you ahead of time if there are additional charges, so you know exactly what you are paying for.
