If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

CREMATION SERVICES OFFERED

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like cardboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). We use a simple cardboard container.

Our charges for simple cremation (without ceremony) include transportation from place of death (within 25 miles of our nearest location); administrative and staff services, refrigeration, cremation container, cremation and filing of the death certificate.

EMBALMING

\$825

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. This fee also includes dressing, cosmetizing and casketing. A cash advance fee will occur if an outside hair dresser is desired.

BASIC SERVICE OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF OVERHEAD

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, burial packages, and forwarding or receiving remains). Our services include: conducting arrangements conference; planning necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.

CASH ADVANCE ITEMS

This list includes prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you. These items may include death certificates, clergy/church honorarium, military/cemetery honorarium, cemetery fees, organist fees, newspaper notices, flowers, hair dresser, etc.

However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements.
